### From the NSI's

Hear from our Naval Science Instructors!

#### CDR Lauper:

"As we say farewell to October, we look forward to November. This is usually a very busy month for us, but this is not a normal year. Most of our competitions will be virtual for the foreseeable future. Troy High School will begin hybrid instruction on Monday, November 2nd. Due to a medical condition that places me and my family at higher risk, I have been granted the accommodation to continue teaching

virtually until it is safe enough for school to return to its normal schedule. Seniors who are in cohorts A or B will continue to receive instruction via Chromebook while they are on campus. Cohort C will continue online learning as before. Each of the other NSIs will communicate their schedules to their Cadets. I am proud of our Cadets, who continue to show great dedication in attending class every day and participating in the learning."

#### Some key dates:

- From the Naval History and Heritage Command (NHHC): Oct. 27, 1922 The Navy League of the United States sponsors the first celebration of Navy Day to focus public attention on the importance of the U.S. Navy. The date is selected because it is Theodore Roosevelt's birthday. Navy Day is last observed Oct. 27, 1949. In the 1970s, Adm. Elmo R. - On November 10th, we celebrate the birthday of the United States Marine Corps. This is normally a time for a ceremony and cake.
