The competition consisted of four navigational challenges: an obstacle course, a slalom, a platform touch-and-go, and a resupply challenge in which competitors used a hook attached to the drone to pick up small payloads and move them to a different platform. Although, the team experienced a number of technical issues, such as faltering connectivity between their controllers and their drone apparatus they persevered and placed second in the touch-and-go challenge. 
Annual Military Inspection
